Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

Diversified Manufacturing provides the knowledge, skills, and technologies required for employment in multi-material technology systems. This project-based course will allow the student to apply academic skills to various manufacturing operations such as welding, machining, forming, manual and CNC technologies. Students will use a variety of power tools, hand tools and stationary equipment throughout this course. Knowledge about career opportunities, requirements, and expectations and the development of workplace skills are included.
