### **Welcome** – *Dr. Linda Macias*

Dr. Linda Macias greeted everyone.

### **Minutes** – *Dr. Linda Macias*

Dr. Macias asked members to review and approve minutes from the September 25, 2014 meeting. Minutes were submitted and accepted as presented.

### **District Improvement Plan (DIP)** – *Dr. Linda Macias*

Dr. Macias reviewed the various parts of the DIP: Mission & Vision statements, needs assessment and the 5 goals. Goal areas include academic achievement; safe & healthy environment; human capital; Communication & community relations; and financial operations and technology management. Input was solicited from DEIC members.

### **AYP Waiver** – *Mary Jadloski*

Mary Jadloski shared the current situation regarding the AYP waiver and the impact on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Algebra I students. Once again, the district will determine the prudence of double testing these students. The USDE declined to grant the TEA waiver that requires all students to be assessed in math once in high school.

### **1<sup>st</sup> EOC Graduation Class** – *Mary Jadloski*

Cy-Fair has 846 students who need to pass one or more EOC assessments in order to graduate. Students must meet all graduation requirements, both testing and credits in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. High school staff are preparing students to retest in December (also in May and July). Senate bill 149 was filed by Senator Seliger and would establish an Individual Graduation Committee (IGC) to determine whether a student may meet other measures that allows him/her to graduate in lieu of passing an EOC.

### **Code of Conduct**-*David Garcia*

David Garcia shared the process for gathering input for the code of conduct. DEIC members input is appreciated. Input deadline is Dec. 19, 2014. More to come in future meetings.

### **Instructional Calendar**-*Dan McIlduff*

Dan McIlduff explained the parameter and process for establishing the 2015-2016 instructional calendar. The committee meets on December 9 and the board will approve the recommended calendar in January.
