SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. A **teaching** scholarship will be awarded in May 2019 to a CFISD graduating high school senior who plans to pursue an **education degree to become a teacher of Health, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance.** **The applicant must be planning on pursuing a major in education in one of the following areas:** Health Education, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance Education. ***(Ex. Pre-med, pharmacy, physical therapy, and nursing majors do not qualify for this scholarship.)*** This scholarship is awarded by the Cypress-Fairbanks H.O.P.E. Association.
2. The criteria used to select the finalist will include economic necessity, scholarship and leadership. **In addition, the applicant must pursue an education degree to become a TEACHER of Health Education, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance Education.**
3. **The completed application should be mailed to the address at the top of the application and must be returned no later than March 29, 2019.**
4. The recipient of the H.O.P.E. scholarship will be notified and, if time permits, recognized at the campus high school awards night. On that night, the recipient will receive written instructions about receiving the scholarship money. The recipient must make use of this scholarship during the fall semester after receiving the award.
