We wanted to provide you with a brief update on the reopening of CFISD for the 2020-2021 school year. Although we were hopeful that the Texas Education Agency (TEA) would provide school districts with guidance on the health and safety protocols that would be required for in-person instruction, TEA has paused on providing this guidance in the midst of the surge in COVID-19 cases in Texas. We are happy to report TEA announced that school districts would receive full funding for students who choose to engage in remote instruction. This is excellent news because it allows students to remain enrolled in CFISD, whether they choose to engage in face-to-face or remote instruction. The curriculum and instruction department is diligently working to make significant improvements to the district's online platform. In the coming weeks, we will provide information on the requirements for online learning and details on the selection process.

We will continue to keep you updated as more information becomes available.
