Per guidance from TEA on Tuesday, July 7, districts are required to offer in-person, face-to-face instruction for students in the fall with remote learning as an option for parents who choose to keep their children home. The Reopening CFISD committee is developing operational plans for both forms of instruction that include numerous health and safety protocols to provide for the well-being of our students and staff. These plans will be finalized and communicated in the next couple of weeks, and then parents will be able to select the form of instruction they prefer for their child(ren). All plans are subject to change based on guidance from local and state officials. The first day of instruction for CFISD is Monday, Aug. 24.
