



Reopening CFISD Cleaning Protocols & Guidelines for Elementary Schools

APPENDIX

Custodians will deep-clean at the end of each school day. Alcohol-based sanitizer spray and paper towels are provided for all areas on campus. Staff sanitizing directions - Spray sanitizer on surfaces, air dry or wipe with paper towel. Sanitizing wipes will be provided as needed.

Classrooms:

Classrooms shall receive sanitizing solution spray bottles and paper towels. Sanitizing wipes will be provided as needed for classroom areas. Sanitizing solution spray bottles shall be used by the teacher within each instructional classroom to sanitize student desk and high touch surfaces throughout the day. First period and last period classes the sanitizing process will not be necessary as custodians will deep-clean the night before and after last period.

Restrooms:

Restrooms shall be disinfected with a hospital grade/EPA-registered disinfectant by day custodians throughout the day as needed.

Cafeteria:

Cafeteria shall be disinfected with a hospital grade/EPA-registered disinfectant after each meal. Students shall remove their own trash after each meal.

Admin/Reception:

Admin / Reception shall be disinfected/sanitized as needed by day custodians. Wipes / sanitizing spray bottles will be utilized by administrative staff as needed.

Gyms:

Gyms shall be sanitized / disinfected between classes by day custodians with assistance from teachers and coaches.

Special Ed / Daycare:

Special Ed / Daycare shall receive sanitizing solution spray bottles and paper towels. Sanitizing wipes will be provided as needed for classroom areas. Sanitizing solution spray bottles shall be used by the teacher within instructional classrooms to sanitize high touch surfaces, toys and manipulatives.

Clinic:

Clinic shall receive sanitizing solution spray bottles, paper towels, and sanitizing wipes to be utilized throughout the day by nurses. Day custodians will disinfect as needed in clinic areas.
