



## Health Screening for Visitors Protocol

### APPENDIX

#### Rationale:

*Out of an abundance of caution and to protect the CFISD community, all visitors to CFISD facilities will be screened (via questioning) about their health and potential or known exposure to COVID-19. This daily measure will help to identify individuals who present with symptoms that could be related to COVID-19.*

#### Protocol:

- All facilities will have hand sanitizer available at each entrance for visitors to use whenever they enter the building.
- Visitors are required to wear face coverings over the nose and mouth and to practice social distancing.
- Before being allowed to enter a CFISD facility each day, each individual will be screened (via questioning):
  1. Are you experiencing any of the following in a way that is not normal to you?:
    - Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0° F
    - Loss of taste or smell
    - Cough
    - Difficulty breathing
    - Shortness of breath
    - Fatigue
    - Headache
    - Chills
    - Sore throat
    - Congestion or runny nose
    - Shaking or exaggerated shivering
    - Significant muscle pain or ache
    - Diarrhea
    - Nausea or vomiting
  2. Have you had known close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
- Any visitor to a CFISD site that fails to satisfactorily answer the screening questions above, shall not be allowed to enter the premise and will not be allowed to be physically present at any CFISD facility for a minimum of fourteen (14) days following exclusion. Additionally, prior to returning to a CFISD site, a visitor must satisfactorily answer the screening questions without the presence of new or worsening symptoms.
- A visitor that is excluded from a CFISD site due to unsatisfactory answers to screening questions shall be allowed other opportunities to conduct business with CFISD through remote or virtual options, to the extent practicable.
