



Use of Face Masks Guidelines

APPENDIX

Face masks include non-medical and medical grade disposable face masks and cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth). Full-face shields may be used in place of a mask to protect eyes, nose, and mouth whenever a mask is not feasible or whenever the education context may benefit from the ability to see an individual's full face.

- All staff and students (grades PK-12) will wear face masks on buses, in hallways and common areas, and when social distancing is not feasible, including in classrooms, to the extent, it is developmentally appropriate.
- Students will wear a face mask when entering and/or exiting the gym, playground, or activity space and when not actively engaged in physical activity.
- Aligned with the Governor's Order, developmentally appropriate would apply to students ten (10) years or older.
- Any student with a medical condition or disability that prevents him/her from wearing a face mask will be exempt from this requirement. Written documentation from a medical provider will be required.
- Face masks must meet the Student Code of Conduct and dress code requirements.
- All visitors (including parents, contractors and vendors) will wear face masks.
- Face masks will be provided for staff and students if needed.
