Note on teacher licensure or certification: The only MS in Education specialization offered by Walden that is state-approved as leading to any educational license or certification is the MS in Education, Educational Leadership and Administration (Principal Licensure Preparation), which has been approved in Ohio for leading to Building Level Principal Licensure (grades P-6, grades 4-9, and grades 5-12). Teachers are advised to contact their individual school districts as to whether this program may qualify for salary advancement.
