State Accountability Update

- * TEA has been working with two committees of educators and community members to develop the new state accountability system.
- * Proposal of one accountability system with four main indicators:
 - * Student Achievement
 - * Student Progress
 - * Closing Performance Gaps
 - * Postsecondary Readiness
- * The Commissioner of Education has not finalized the accountability system or the performance standards.

Federal Accountability Update

- * March 1, 2013: State announced submittal of AYP Waiver
- * Waiver requests that the state accountability system and intervention system be used for federal AYP requirements so that there will no longer be two separate systems.
- * TEA has until April 15, 2013 to submit final request.
- * We do not know when or if the waiver will be granted.
