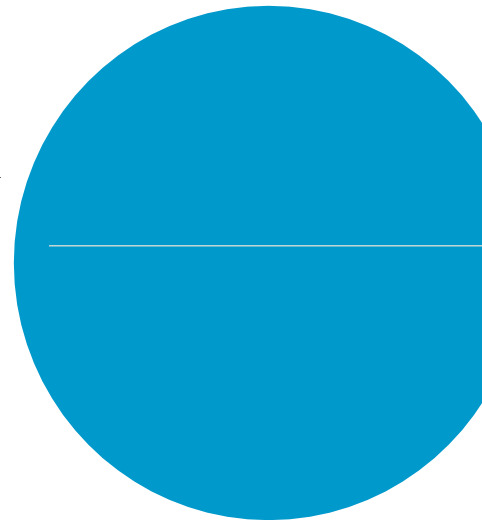

Tuition

The projected tuition for the Class of 2016 is \$95,500. An enrollment deposit of \$1,000 is due upon acceptance and will be applied toward your first semester bill. The remaining tuition is billed in four installments that may be covered by the use of personal resources, financial aid or private loans. Houston area educators may apply for partial tuition reimbursement after the successful completion of the REEP MBA Program. If they meet the eligibility requirements, REEP may reimburse graduates between 75 to 80% of the tuition cost.

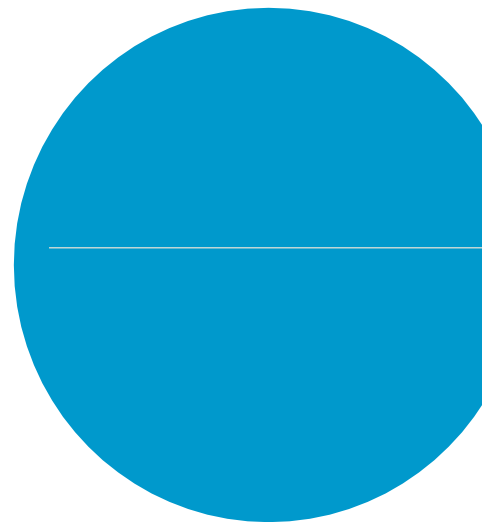
