**Qualifications:** Texas A&M University is expanding its commitment to low and middle income students through the Aggie Assurance program. The Aggie Assurance aids students with family income below \$60,000 by pledging to provide enough scholarships and grants to pay tuition for all eligible\* students. The Aggie Assurance encourages Texans to pursue higher education at a flagship, research institution.

### **Eligibility**

- You must be a Texas resident and eligible to pay resident tuition.
- You must be an entering freshman or undergraduate transfer student beginning in the summer or fall 2008 semester or beyond. (current students who entered Texas A&M prior to the Summer 2008 semester are not eligible)
- You must be a degree-seeking student.
- You (if you are an independent student) or you and your parent(s) (if you are a dependent student) must have an adjusted gross income of \$60,000 or less.
- You must be admitted and enrolled full-time at Texas A&M University-College Station.
- You must have financial need as determined by the FAFSA or TASFA.
- You must maintain a 2.5 GPA and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements.
- You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by our March 1 priority date prior to the fall semester.

Aggie Assurance covers tuition – state mandated, designated tuition, and differential tuition. In essence, this is a commitment by the university that those below \$60,000 in income will always have grants and scholarships to meet the tuition costs. At this time, the program does not include fees.

**Other Documents Needed:** There is not a separate application for Aggie Assurance. Once you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), Scholarships & Financial Aid will determine if you are eligible and notify you of program eligibility
