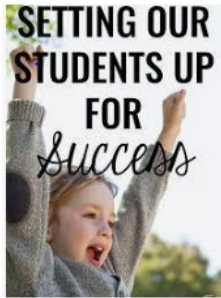

EARLY RELEASE

If you need to pick up your child prior to dismissal time, please send a note that includes the following:

- The parent's/guardian's signature;
- the date and time the student will be picked up;
- the name of the person who will be picking up the student; and,
- the reason for the early dismissal.

You must also call the office to confirm our receipt of your early release note. We will make every effort to honor your request. **Not sending a note may cause a delay in picking up your student.**

The parent or the approved parent designee, who is picking up the child from school, **must show a state-issued photo ID** or be listed as an Emergency Contact for your child. All Emergency Contact pick-ups must be validated with the parent before release. **(A state-issued photo ID is required to enter the building).**

Changes in your child's after school transportation cannot be made after 2:00 p.m.

PARENT LUNCH VISITATIONS

Our Parent Lunch Visitations have begun. Due to space restrictions, **visitations will be limited to one day per week, beginning Tuesday, October 18, 2022.** We will revisit this topic as time goes on.

Visitations are limited to one parent or guardian. You may bring lunch for, and eat with, your child only. **On non-visitiation days, please ensure your students bring their lunches to school.**
