Title: Nurse Corps Scholarship Program

Deadline: May 2, 2024

Award Amount: \$10,000

The Nurse Corps Scholarship Program provides scholarships to nursing students in exchange for a minimum two-year, full-time service commitment (or part-time equivalent) at an eligible health care facility with a critical shortage of nurses. A complete understanding of the commitment to serve at a Critical Shortage Facility and the financial, legal, and other consequences of failing to perform the commitment is critical to successfully completing the mandatory service obligation associated with a Nurse Corps Scholarship award.

Eligibility/Requirements:

Am I eligible for a scholarship? You are eligible if you:

- ✓ Are a U.S. citizen (born or naturalized), a national, or a lawful permanent resident
- ✓ Are an accepted or enrolled student in a nursing degree program at a United States accredited school of nursing
- ✓ Begin classes no later than September 30
- ✓ Don't have any federal judgment liens
- ✓ Don't have an existing service commitment
- ✓ Aren't overdue on a federal debt

Eligible Applicants and Programs

Students accepted or enrolled at an accredited school of nursing located in the United States or territory, pursuing a nursing degree or certificate program. Types of eligible nursing programs include:

- Diploma in Nursing
- Associate degree in Nursing
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Graduate-level nurse practitioner
- Graduate level advanced registered nurse
