Scope and Sequence 2023-2024

Course Description: PFL+Economics is an integrative course that applies the same economic way of thinking developed to making choices about how to allocate scarce resources in an economy to how to make them at the personal level. It requires demonstrated critical thinking by students who explore how to invest in themselves with education and skill development, how to earn income, how to budget for spending, saving, investing, and protecting. Students will examine their individual responsibility for managing their personal finances and will understand that doing so will impact their standard of living and long-term financial well-being.
