Scope and Sequence 2022-2023

Course Description: Art, Music, Theater (AMT) - 12 weeks or 1 semester

Sixth grade students may participate in a fine arts rotation of either three 12-week courses or two semester courses in the areas of art, music and theater arts. The campus determines the classes in the rotation model offered.

This basic art course includes drawing, painting, design, and sculpture, as well as the study of artists, their ideas, and cultures. Emphasis on creative thinking and originality provides a foundation for future art courses.
