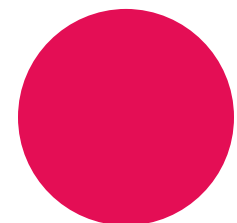
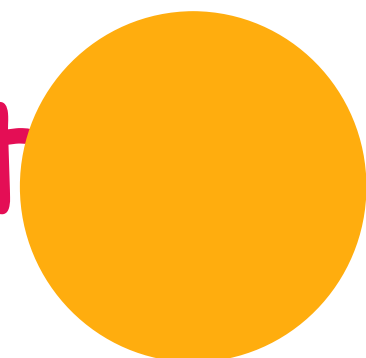




Hello Teachers,
