Here are some examples:

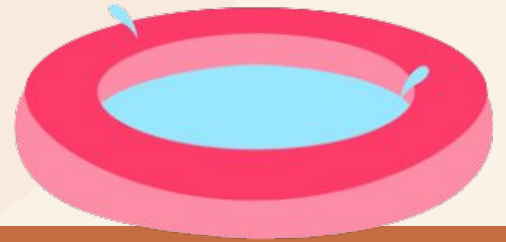
How to ride a bicycle



How to tie your shoes

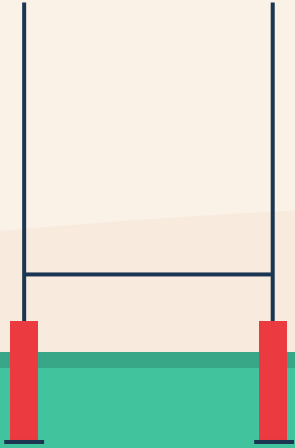


How to learn to swim

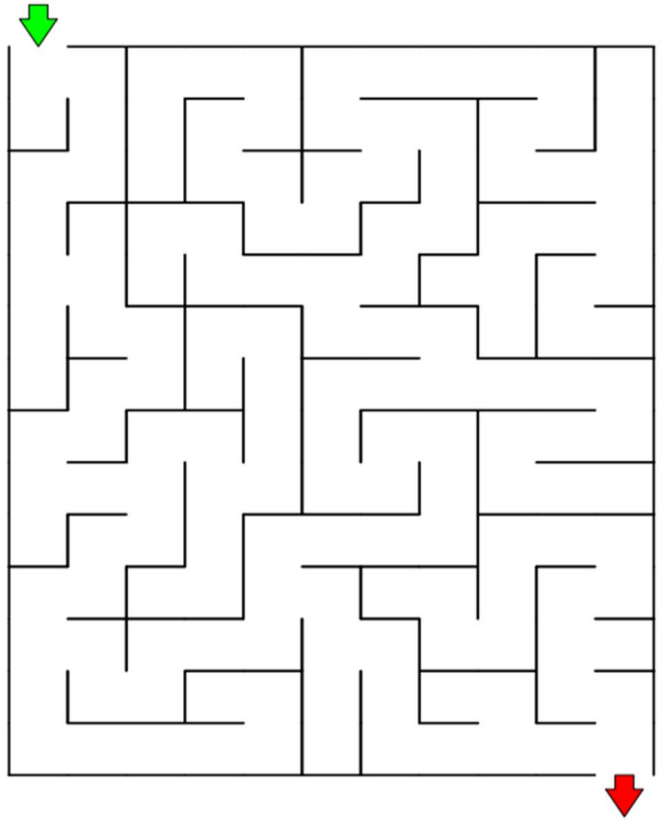

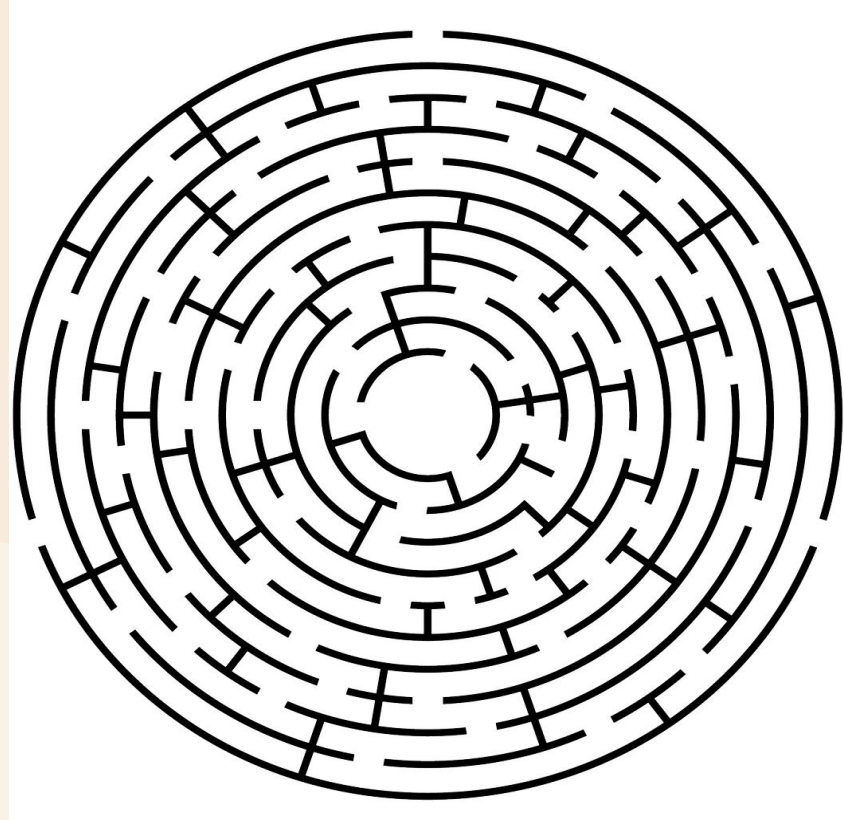
